This could be a surfer on a wave, a windsurfer, a diver, a swimmer, a bird catching a fish, a whale, dolphin, boat, jet ski, or a jet of water or wave causing motion, water droplets etc.
Wednesday Feb 22	PRESENTATION	BIRDS WITH MATTHEW JONES	Matthew is a professional photographer of wildlife and birds. He is an ecologist who has captured some rare and interesting pictures of wildlife.

Wednesday Mar 8	ASSESSMENT	PHOTOJOURNALISM	Photojournalism is telling stories with photographs. The story is more important than the picture quality. Facial expressions, emotions, movement and body posture as well as composition tell a story in the same way as words.

Wednesday April 12	ASSESSMENT	BIRDS (Submit digital images for May)	Birds in their natural environment. The bird must <b>not</b> be in a nest. They can be stationary or flying. Consider room for the bird to move forward in the frame.
