An overview of the attractions we may photograph in March in the Blue Mountains are.

- Major attraction; the Grand Canyon Track. Features, waterfalls, rain forests, deep narrow canyon. It is a 6.3 km loop, well formed, many steps, grade 3 rating. About 3 to 4 hrs duration.
- Waterfalls; Bridle Vale, Wentworth, Leura Cascades, Fairy falls, Katoomba falls,
- Lookouts; Princes rock, Sublime Point, Honeymoon, Boars Head, Cahill's, Pulpit Rock, Echo Point, Eagle Hawk, Narrow Neck, Landslide, Cliff view, Malaita,
- Everglades Historic House and gardens
- Blue Mountains Chocolate Factory
- Leuralla Train and Railway Museum
- Hydro Majestic
- Scenic Railway, Skyway
- Walks; Three sisters, Dante's Glen,

The following treks for the year, (all based around a weekend), will be:

- South Coast beaches including Horse Head and Camel Rocks, 13 to 19th May.
- Mayfield and Japanese gardens 9th to 16th Sept.
- Lithgow and surrounds 11th to 17th November.
