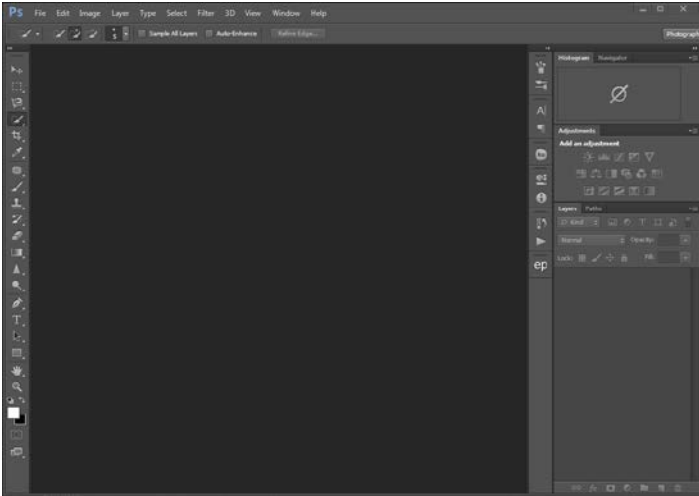


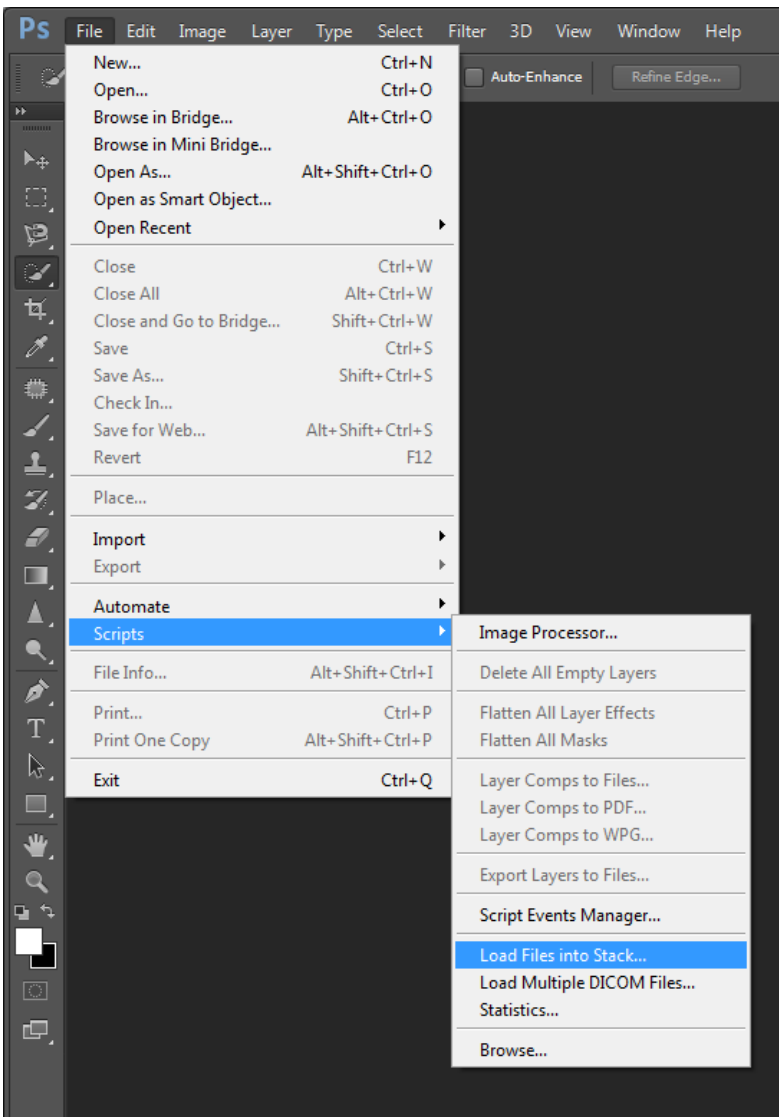
Photoshop CS6 – Focus Stacking

To load the required images to be stacked as layers:

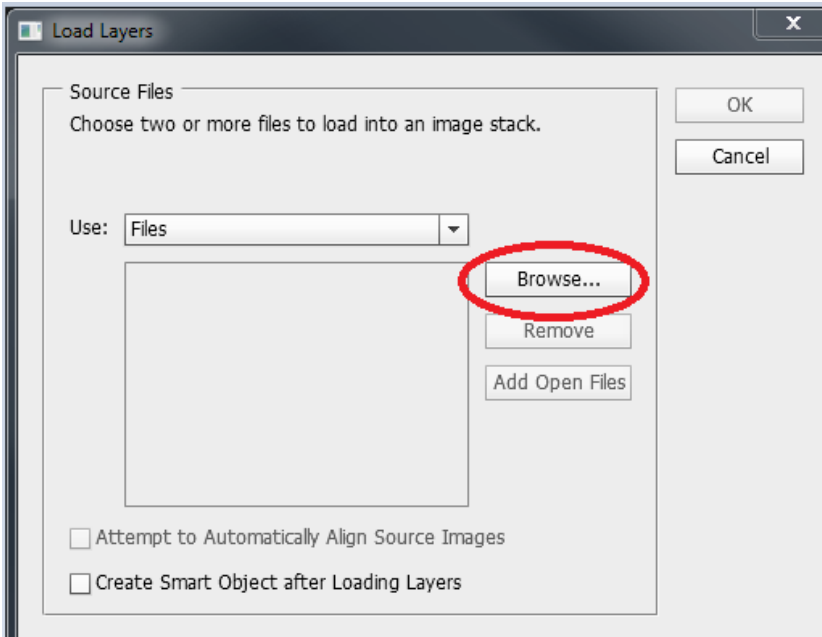
1. Open Photoshop CS6



2. File – Scripts – Load Files into Stack...

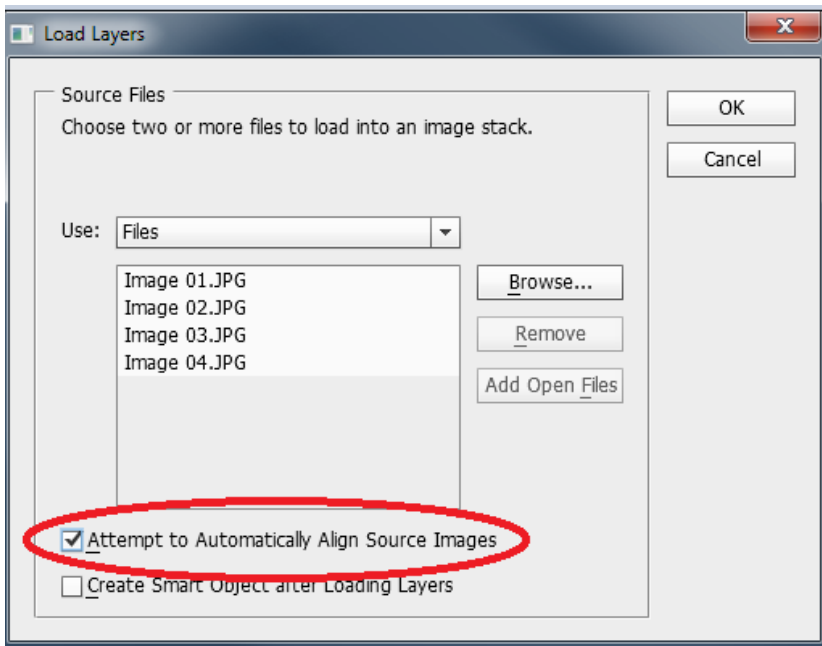


3. Browse to select the required images



4. At this point you can choose tick “Attempt to Automatically Align Source Images” and “OK” if you wish, and then move onto item 10 (I would suggest that this would be the easiest option)

Note: It will be the filenames of your selected files that will appear in the list.

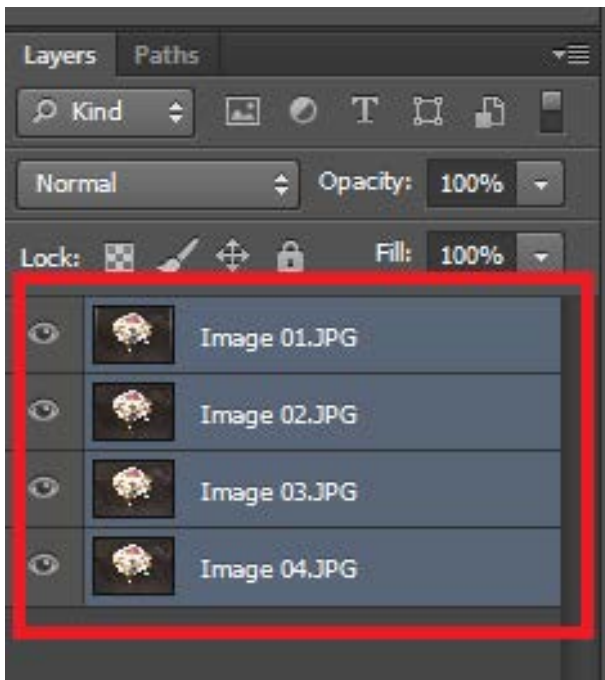


Or after the images have been imported:

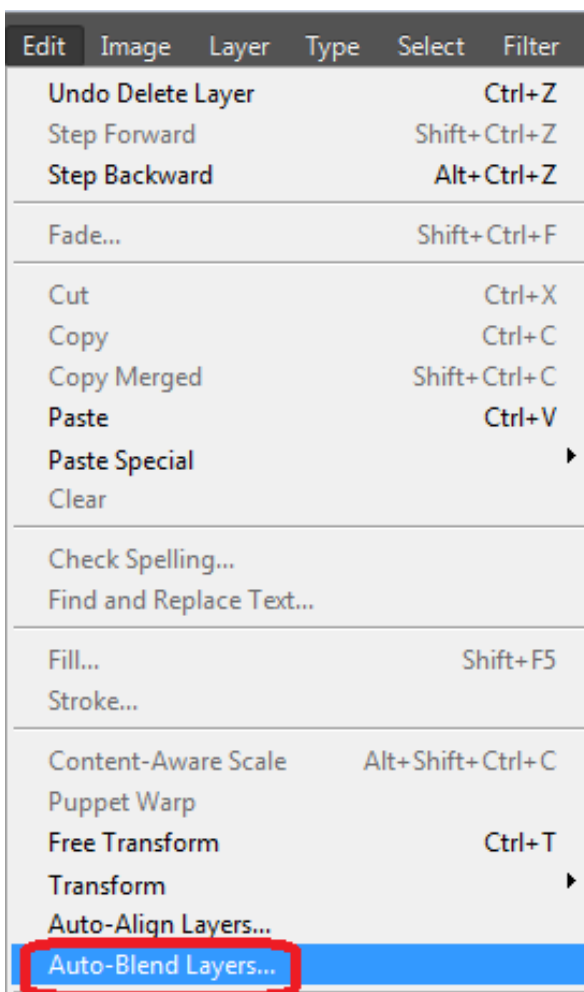
5. Select the Move tool
6. Click on the 1st layer
7. Shift+Click on the last layer
8. Click on the “Auto-Align Layers” icon
(located on the top of the screen next to “3D Mode” and is only visible if the Move tool is selected or if you wish you can go to Edit – Auto-Align Layers...)

9. Select Auto

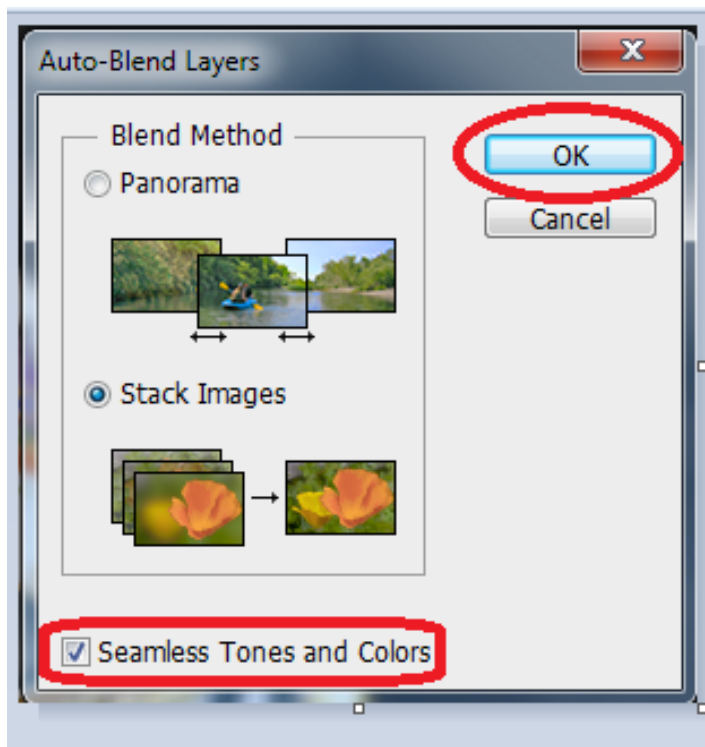
10. Select all layers



11. Edit – Auto-Blend Layers...



12. Select Stack Images and Seamless Tones and Colors and OK



13. Flatten the image

14. Do any required editing

15. Save the image
