Preliminary outline for next year's 2018 trek

The itinerary is timed to fit between Father's day Sun 2nd September and school holidays starting end 21st September in Victoria & 28th Sep in NSW.

All roads are suitable for all vehicles and caravans.

History;

In the 50's I spent all my Christmas Holidays at Longerenong Ag college near Horsham, the Wimmera and Grampian's were my playground.

In the 60's my Uncle retired to Maldon a mining town near Castlemaine and Bendigo.

I then live in East Doncaster for 12 years from 1973.

The Trek;

We will start at Rutherglen on Tuesday 4th Sep 2018 for wine buffs and officially Wed afternoon the 5th for trip briefing; giving members time to pack on the Monday after Father's day.

The first week through to Sunday 9th we will be visiting Echuca, the Silo Art trail and the Horsham in Wimmera wheat district.

Members wishing to do a shorter version may join us on Sunday 9th for the second week to explore Grampian's & Surrounds.

In the 3rd week we will be visiting Sovereign Hill Ballarat, Dalesford (Heritage train Ride), Hepburn Springs, and the mining towns, Maldon, (Steam train ride to Castlemaine) and Bendigo (Central Deborah Gold Mine, Old tram trips) . Trek will finish around Sat 22nd.
